THE DREAM LEAGUE INAUGURAL SEASON 2007

The Dream League is a division of First Colony Little League (FCLL). It was established in the Fall of 2006 with a launch in the Spring of 2007. The FCLL Board of Directors along with several parents, The Fort Bend Independent School District and The Arc of Ft. Bend initiated the Dream League to enable children with physical and/or mental disabilities to enjoy the game of baseball.



This Dream League falls under the umbrella and charter of First Colony Little League. FCLL is one of the premiere Little League programs in the United States. It has been an integral part of the Fort Bend community for over 20 years and has served over 11,000 players.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING THE GAME

A key to the success of the Dream League is the volunteer Managers, Coaches, Team Parents and “Angels in the Outfield.” They organize the teams and conduct the games on the field. The Manager and Coaches are the pitchers and catchers and keep the flow of the game going.



A Team Parent is assigned to each team and helps with communication, scheduling, pictures and volunteers. “Angels in the Outfield” are boys and girls who volunteer to assist the players. Their job is to help the players during the game and become a loyal “buddy or angel” to them.

Every player bats each inning and the side is retired after each player on the team gets a chance to bat.

No score is kept during game, but each player gets a chance to score a run and celebrate during each inning. The players wear the same uniforms, shoulder patches and safety equipment as every other Little League player!

THE SEASON

The season coincides with the FCLL season. Opening day will be March 24th and we hope to have 4 teams in our Dream League. Each team will play six (6) games during the season and each game will be played on Saturday at the FCLL complex.
